

Drum Hire Conditions for Djembe Class students

If you'd like to practise outside of classes we can loan you a djembe for \$20 per week.

Hire Conditions

1. Drums should be kept in a dry and safe environment to avoid any weather or other damage. Drums must be returned in the same condition they were provided. Any damage beyond normal wear and tear may result in repair charges.
2. If the drum is not returned for any reason, the hirer will be liable for the full replacement cost of the drum.
3. The hirer will be charged weekly to their nominated credit card unless they choose to pay cash at the time of their weekly Djembe class. Your credit card number will be taken at the commencement of hire and kept on file.
4. You may swap your drum during the hire period without additional fees. Please make sure you log this with your teacher as some drums are on our website and need to have their details noted down. Only a select batch of our drums are available for hire. Your teacher will show you which ones.
5. Weekly hire fees still apply even if classes aren't running, or you can return the drum during these periods if you wish.

Rent to Own Plan

In the highly likely event that you fall in love with your djembe, we can make ownership official with our Rent to Own plan. The conditions are set out below:

1. The amount you've paid in continuous hire fees* will be deducted from the total cost of the drum. This credit is valid up to 4 weeks following the date you dropped the drum back to the shop. Please make sure you touch base with a member of staff when you drop off the drum.
2. Online sales do not apply to drum hire/purchase scenarios
3. Hire credit can only be applied toward the purchase of a djembe drum and djembe bag, not for other instruments, accessories, services or workshops.
4. **Continuous Hire Fees:** Hire credits do not accrue if there are breaks between hire periods. Only the credit from your most recent continuous hire period is valid.
5. If weekly classes are not run due to a Public Holiday or the end-of-year break, you can return your djembe and rehire it when the next cycle starts. In this case, the hire will still be considered continuous. However, if the djembe is returned for any other reason, the hire is no longer considered continuous.

By taking possession of the hired drum, you acknowledge that you have read, understood, and agree to abide by the conditions outlined in this document.
